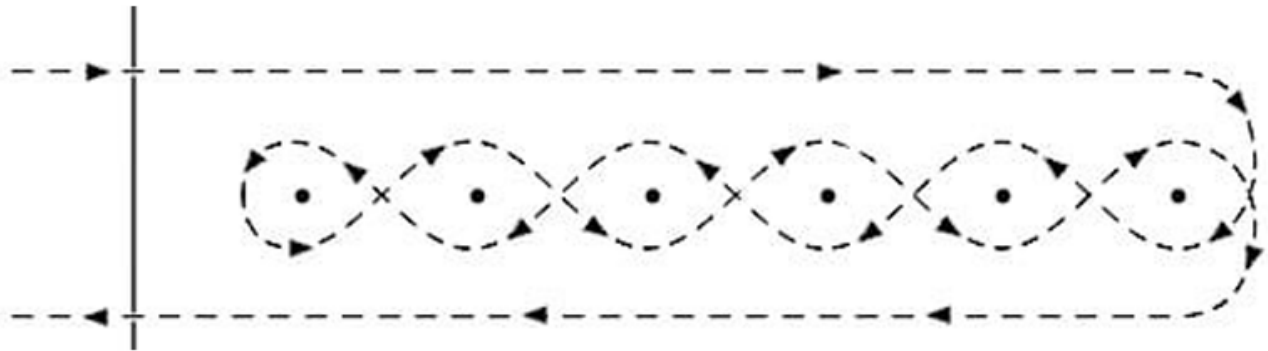
Head on over and complete in between classes.

Western Bending

Rider rides straight up on the left hand side of poles, turns round the end pole, and bends back through poles, round the first pole, bending back to the end pole, around the end pole and straight back to the finish line.

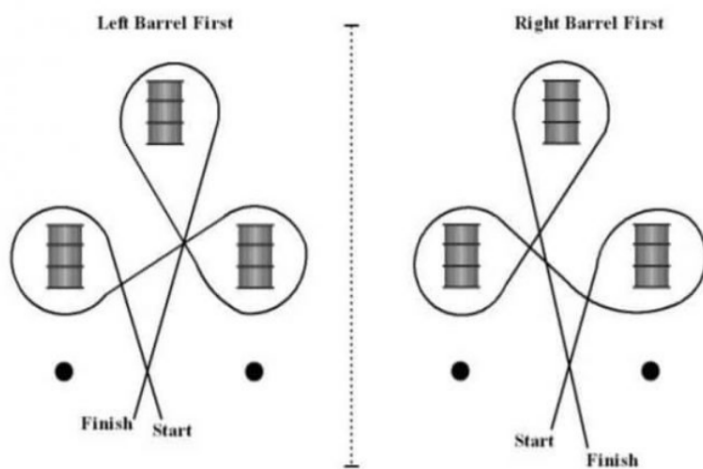
Judged on time and accuracy



Barrels

Riders enter at the start line, circle around the 1st barrel, proceed to the 2nd barrel, and then continue on to the 3rd where they will complete the pattern and finally exit the course crossing the finish a second time. This pattern is often referred to as a "Cloverleaf" The pattern may begin with the left or right barrel first.

Judged on time, however 5 second penalty applies if you knock a barrel over
